## Happy New Year from SHMC!

Strength and Honor MC had an outstanding 2022 spending time in our communities, holding fundraisers, identifying opportunities to support and assist those in need and participating in activities that pay tribute to and show respect for those that have fallen. Last year's fundraising efforts resulted in providing \$156,405.35 in assistance to the families of fallen public safety personnel and veterans. We would like to take this opportunity to express our gratitude and appreciation for organizations and people like you that helped make all this possible by your generous support. As we look ahead to 2023, here are some



examples from 2022 that highlight how your support was put into action.

## Remembering the Fallen

### **Beirut Memorial Ride**

This past October SHMC chapters from VA, MD, NJ, PA and NC converged on Jacksonville, NC to honor the 241 Marines, Sailors, and Soldier who lost their lives on 23 October 1983 while conducting peace-keeping operations in Beirut Lebanon.



Led by SHMC's NC chapter, the event was well supported by other motorcycle riders from all over the region raising \$3,000 in donations. Proceeds from the event went to Patrol Base Abbate, a veterans support organization whose mission is to provide warriors space to re calibrate inside the wire and community to thrive outside the wire.

## Davey's Battle Brothers Memorial Ride

In September, SHMC hosted the annual Davey's Battle Brothers Ride. This event is held in honor of Sgt. David Alan Ruhren from Stafford, VA who was killed on December 21, 2004 along with 13 other U.S. service members including National Guard Sgt. Nicholas Mason of King George



County, VA by a suicide bomber in Mosul, Iraq. This year the event raised \$2,200 and a donation was made to the veterans support organization War Horse Forge.

### **Quantico National Cemetery Wreath Laying**

On December 3<sup>rd</sup>, SHMC supported the Sgt. Mac Foundation annual Christmas wreath laying ceremony. The Sgt. Mac Foundation was initially formed to honor the memory of Marine Sgt. Eric McColley. On February 17, 2006, Sgt. McColley gave his life for his country along with seven fellow Marines and two Airmen.



The National Wreath Project has evolved to placing wreaths at the graves of Veterans at Quantico National Cemetery and Gettysburg National Cemetery in Pennsylvania. Led by SHMC's Gray Ghost chapter, to support this foundation and their efforts to honor the memory of our fallen veterans, SHMC raised \$39,220 and placed 16,000 wreaths at Quantico National Cemetery.

This year we added a charity softball game to make the event a double header! Members of the Stafford County Sheriff's Office (Guns) matched up against members from the Fredericksburg, Stafford, King George, Fairfax & Fauquier Fire Departments (Hoses) for the Guns & Hoses Softball Match.



The Fire Department scored the most runs but

everyone was a winner in this game! On behalf of the Fire Department, a check for \$1,000 was presented to Mary's Shelter, Inc. This is becoming one of our signature fundraising events raising \$6,633.20 for assisting those in need from our local community.



### SHMC Bike Night

On the 3rd Thursday of the month April – October from 6-8pm, SHMC hosted a bike night at 6 Bears and a Goat, Fredericksburg, VA. In addition to the entertainment, there are door prizes and a 50/50 drawing. This event generated over \$5,000 last year with the proceeds going to assist local families or organizations in need.
